Job Related Education Requirements:

The Apprentice is recommended to complete approximately **144** contact hours of related education for each year of the Apprenticeship.

Courses may be taken during or outside regular working hours, upon the discretion of the employer.

Application Process:

2. Complete the [Apprenticeship Application](#) – This application is reviewed by York Tech then submitted to the Employer when complete and the Employer makes the hiring decision: **Must include, cover letter, resume, and 2 letters of reference**
