Course Descriptions:

- **CRJ 281: Police Science I (3 credit hours)** - Course topics include but are not limited to: Intro to Criminal Law, Courts, Crimes, and Procedures, First Amend., Basic Patrol Operations, & Traffic Law. After successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to complete the SCCJA certification exam for these instructional blocks.
- **CRJ 282: Police Science II (3 credit hours)** - Course topics include but are not limited to: Domestic Violence, Juv. Procedures, & Victimology. After successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to complete the SCCJA certification exam for these instructional blocks.
- **CRJ 283: Police Science III (3 credit hours)** - Course topics include but are not limited to: Report Writing, Interviewing, Officer Survival, Drug Enforcement, and Crime Scene & Physical Evidence. After successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to complete the SCCJA certification exam for these instructional blocks.
- **CRJ 284: Police Science IV (3 credit hours)** - Course topics include but are not limited to: Basic Collision Investigation, Uniform Traffic Ticket, Vehicle Tactics, and Mind Armor. After successful completion of this course, students will be eligible to complete the SCCJA certification exam for these instructional blocks.
