The **Youth Electrical/Mechatronics Technician** is a federally registered apprenticeship program with the Department of Labor. Successful candidates will receive a nationally recognized Journeyman certificate upon completion of the program.

The apprentice will be training in the following work processes:

Preliminary Work and Safety
Total Productive Maintenance
Familiarization with Breakdown Procedures
Troubleshooting and Programmable Logic Controls
Learning names and uses of the various tools used in assembling this material, care of these tools, and other instructions necessary to familiarize the apprentices with the material and tools of the trade.
Learning the names and uses of the equipment used in the trade, such as kind, size, and use of cable, wire, boxes, conduits, and fittings, switches, receptacles, service switches, cutouts, etc.

Job Related Education Requirements:

The Apprentice is recommended to complete approximately **144** contact hours of related education for each year of the Apprenticeship.

Courses may be taken during or outside regular working hours, upon the discretion of the employer.
