WHAT COURSES SHOULD STUDENTS COMPLETE BEFORE TRANSFERRING TO CLEMSON?

Students should complete coursework toward their intended major, following Clemson University curriculum maps. Please see provided curriculum plans to ensure proper courses are taken. Completing coursework that does not directly apply to the intended major may extend a student's graduation plan once they transfer to Clemson.



WHAT ELSE SHOULD STUDENTS DO TO MAKE SURE THE TRANSFER PROCESS IS SMOOTH?

Students should schedule a meeting with a College of Education academic advisor. To contact the secondary and special education advisor, email educationundergrad@clemson.edu or call (864) 656-3180. CRITERIA FOR TRANSFERRING

- Minimum 2.75 GPA from a student's previous institution
- Minimum 30 credit hours of college study, completed after high school graduation, that begin to satisfy the course requirements of the intended major

CRITERIA FOR ACCEPTANCE TO PROFESSIONAL-LEVEL COURSEWORK

- Completion of one of the following by end of first semester for fall transfers or end of February for spring transfers:
 - Minimum SAT score of 1100
 - Minimum ACT score of 22
 - Passing scores on all sections of the Praxis I: Core Academic Skills for Educators exam (ets.org)

HOW CAN TRANSFER STUDENTS ENSURE THAT COURSES TAKEN ELSEWHERE ARE EQUIVALENT TO CLEMSON REQUIREMENTS?

The Transfer Course Equivalency List (TCEL) is a tool on Clemson University's website that contains course equivalencies for approximately 1,200 accredited colleges and universities nationwide. Courses that have previously transferred to Clemson University can be viewed in the TCEL. Students can follow the curriculum outline in Clemson's Undergraduate Catalog for the degree program that they plan to pursue and take equivalent courses listed in the TCEL: www.clemson.edu/admissions/tcel/

Please be advised that the TCEL is only a history of how courses have transferred to Clemson and does not represent a comprehensive list of transferrable courses for any school. If students have taken a course that is not showing a Clemson equivalency on the TCEL, it will be evaluated by the Office of Admissions upon acceptance.
